Respondents' Status Report

The Respondents provide this status report regarding the Court's November 17 order on the Petitioner Miguel Hernandez's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunctive Relief and Request for an Immediate Hearing, [Dkt. 5] (the "Order"). This Status Report is supplemented by the Declaration of Anthony Mockabee, a Deportation Officer working in the ICE/ERO Field Office in Atlanta, Georgia, attached as an exhibit to this report.

1. Respondents acknowledge receipt of the Order.
2. Respondents are working on a response brief, which they plan to

file on Thursday, November 20, per the schedule set out in the Order.

3. Respondents acknowledge that Petitioner Hernandez was in the Northern District of Georgia at the time the underlying petition was filed. Therefore, Respondents do not contest this Court's habeas jurisdiction over this matter. (Other jurisdictional issues, if any, are reserved.)
4. The Order restrains the Respondents from removing Petitioner Hernandez from the Northern District. On November 17 at approximately 4:41 pm, ICE transferred Petitioner Hernandez from Atlanta Georgia (Mockabee Decl. ¶ 4.) He subsequently arrived at the Stewart Detention Center, located in Lumpkin Georgia in the Middle District of Georgia, at approximately 8:30 pm. (*Id.*) It was not until November 17 at 6:14 pm that counsel for Petitioner Hernandez served Respondents with a copy of the Order. [Dkt. 6 - Notice of Service].
5. The Stewart Detention Center has the capacity for longer-term stays. (*Id.* ¶ 5.) It also has televideo capabilities that can be used for court appearances or to meet with counsel. (*Id.* ¶ 6.) Counsel for Petitioner Hernandez is aware of his location.

DECLARATION OF Anthony Mockabee

I, Anthony Mockabee, declare as follows:

1. I have been employed with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Enforcement and Removal Operations (“ICE/ERO”) since 2024. I am currently a (a)Supervisory Detention and Deportation Officer working in the ICE/ERO Field Office in Atlanta, Georgia assigned to the position of acting Supervisory Detention and Deportation Officer.
2. I provide this declaration based on my personal knowledge, belief, reasonable inquiry, and information obtained from various records, systems, databases, other DHS employees, employees of DHS contract facilities, and information portals maintained and relied upon by DHS in the regular course of business.
3. In my capacity as (a)Supervisory Detention and Deportation Officer, I am familiar with the case Miguel Hernandez (“Petitioner”), whose alien registration number is A ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~. I have reviewed documents and official government records pertaining to the Petitioner and, unless otherwise stated, this declaration is based on that review.

4. ICE records demonstrate that Petitioner was transferred to Stewart Detention Center (SDC) on November 17, 2025. His departure from Atlanta is recorded in an ICE database which reflects a "Book Out Date/Time" of November 17, at 1641/4:41 PM. His arrival at SDC was recorded in an ICE database which reflects a "Book In Date/Time" of November 17, 2025 at 2030/8:30 PM.
5. SDC is located in Lumpkin, Georgia, and can accommodate any detention that may exceed 30 days.
6. SDC does have televideo capability should a detainee need to appear for a hearing outside the facility.

Pursuant to Title 28, U.S. Code Section 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, this November 19, 2025.
