**STATUS REPORT**

On December 23, 2025, the Court entered an opinion and judgment granting Lovejeet Singh's petition for a writ of habeas corpus (ECF Nos. 6 and 7). The Court further ordered that Respondents file a status report certifying compliance with the Court's judgment.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement provided Petitioner with a bond hearing on January 2, 2026, where bond was granted. (Ex. A, Bond Order.) The Order contains the following alternatives to detention at DHS's discretion: "[N]o violations of traffic, criminal or immigration laws; and Respondent must get prior permission from DHS before changing his address." (*Id.*)
