

4. On December 18, 2025, ICE Enforcement and Removal Operations (“ERO”) informed Petitioner’s counsel that Petitioner could be picked up at ERO’s office next to the Laredo Processing Center at 11 a.m. on December 19, 2025.

5. The Parties confirm that Petitioner Diane Ekembe was released from custody on December 19, 2025, to a public location, namely the ERO office adjacent to the Laredo Processing Center.

6. Upon Ms. Ekembe’s release, ICE issued an Order of Supervision (“OSUP”) imposing various conditions on Ms. Ekembe’s release. *See Ex. 1*, OSUP. Among other conditions, the OSUP requires that Ms. Ekembe (1) enroll and participate in an Alternatives to Detention (“ATD”) program with GPS ankle monitoring, (2) register in a substance abuse program within 14 days and provide ICE with written proof of registration, and (3) register in a sexual deviancy counseling program within 14 days and provide ICE with written proof of registration. OSUP, at 1, 3. Ms. Ekembe objects to these conditions and reserves the right to formally object to these condition of her OSUP. She will submit an additional filing on this issue.

7. The undersigned counsel for Petitioner contacted the undersigned AUSA seeking clarification or stating concerns regarding some of the conditions for release.

8. The undersigned AUSA has contacted ICE regarding Petitioner’s questions and concerns and is awaiting response and more information.

9. The parties will supplement this status report once these terms of release have been fully clarified.
