ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Petitioner Jose Luis Velazquez Velazquez filed for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. (ECF No. 1, PageID.5). Velazquez alleged that Respondents have detained him without a bond hearing in violation of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), and that his continued detention without a hearing violates his Fifth Amendment right to Due Process. (*Id.* at PageID.21–24). In his petition, Velazquez indicated that he was being detained at the Monroe County Jail in Monroe, Michigan. (*Id.* at PageID.3). But in his supplemental brief, Velazquez stated that he has been detained at North Lake Correctional Facility in

Baldwin, Michigan, since Respondents apprehended him. (ECF No. 3, PageID.59–60). To ensure that the Court has jurisdiction to resolve the petition, the Court will order Velazquez to clarify where he is currently being detained. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Velazquez must respond to the Court’s show cause order, in writing, by November 24, 2025, and provide where he is being detained currently.
