**Respondents' Status Report**

COME NOW Respondents, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas and hereby file their Status Report confirming that Rolando Rafael Inclan Lopez has been released:

1) On December 30, 2025, the Court ordered that 1) Respondents release Petitioner from custody under conditions of release no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue in this case, to a public place no later than 4 p.m. on January 2, 2026; 2) Respondents notify Petitioner's counsel of the exact location and time of Petitioner's release as soon as practicable; and 3) Respondents file a status report no later than 12 p.m. on January 5, 2026, confirming that Petitioner has been released under conditions of release no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue in this case. ECF No. 16 at 3.

2) Petitioner, Rolando Rafale Inclan Lopez, was released on January 1, 2026, at approximately 12:46 p.m. Petitioner's counsel was contacted on January 1, 2026 at approximately 8:56 a.m., but their office was closed. A voicemail was left giving Petitioner's counsel the release information for later that day. Petitioner was granted voluntary departure under safeguard and to

depart by April 9, 2026. Petitioner is to report in person on April 2, 2026 to SNA Resident Office to verify departure arrangements.
