Dear Judge O'Hearn,

I am in receipt of the Government's letter from earlier today. Counsel for the Government did contact me on Friday afternoon to explain the situation, though that does not absolve the Immigration Court of its failure to even attempt to hold, or schedule, the bond hearing in compliance with this Court's Order. The Immigration Court did not attempt to contact immigration counsel at all on Friday, and as of the writing of this letter, I have no indication from immigration counsel that the immigration court has attempted to contact him this morning.

Because of the immigration court's willful disregard of this Court's Order, and the present conditions that make it virtually impossible to obtain a Due Process Compliant hearing in the immigration court (see publicly available information about advertisements for Deportation Judges rather than Immigration Judges, firings of dozen of immigration judges with experience and history of fair adjudications in favor of military judges with no immigration experience, and recent published decisions of the Board of Immigration Appeals, all of which have reduced rights before the

immigration courts), we ask this Court to order Mr. Hernandez Maldonado's release or to conduct the bond hearing in this Court.
