**STATUS REPORT AND PROOF OF SERVICE**

Petitioner filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, Doc. 1, and a Motion for  
Temporary Restraining Order, Doc. 2. On November 20, 2025, this Court granted Petitioner's  
Motion and ordered her immediate release from ICE detention. Doc. 3. In its Order, the Court  
instructed: "this Order **SHALL** be served on defendants such that they receive actual notice as  
soon as possible" and Petitioner "shall file proof of service or a status report" by 5 p.m. on  
November 21, 2025. Doc. 3. In compliance with that Order, Petitioner, through undersigned

1 counsel, files this status report confirming actual notice. This status report is supported by  
2 Exhibit A, a declaration of counsel.

3 Yesterday afternoon, after filing the habeas petition, undersigned counsel sent a copy of  
4 the filings to AUSA Pamela Johann, Civil Division Chief for the U.S. Attorney's Office for the  
5 Northern District of California. Ex. A at ¶ 4. AUSA Johann confirmed receipt. In the evening,  
6 after receiving the Court's Order, undersigned counsel sent the Order, along with file-stamped  
7 copies of all the filings in the case, to AUSA Johann. Ex. A at ¶ 5. AUSA Johann confirmed that  
8 she had provided the Order to Respondents' counsel and that she was coordinating with ICE to  
9 release Petitioner. Ex. A at ¶ 6. Later in the evening, Petitioner's counsel received notice from  
10 AUSA Johann that Petitioner had been released. Ex. A at ¶ 6. The release time was estimated at  
11 7:45 p.m.

12 Counsel for Petitioner has submitted proposed summonses to the Court. Doc. 5.  
13 Petitioner e-mailed the proposed summonses to AUSA Johann, along with the Standing Orders  
14 for this Court. Ex. A at ¶ 7. When the summonses are returned to Petitioner, counsel will serve  
15 them (and the other required documents) on the parties and the U.S. Attorney's Office, in  
16 compliance with Rule 4 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Proof of that service will be  
17 filed when the mailings are received.
