STIPULATION AND ORDER

Petitioner Arda Yilmaz (“Petitioner” or “Yilmaz”) and all respondents (“Respondents”) stipulate as follows:

1. Following his detention by Immigration and Customs Enforcement on November 17, 2025, Petitioner was initially held at the Federal Detention Center in Philadelphia.

2. On November 20, 2025, Yilmaz filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus asserting claims under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a); 8 C.F.R. §§ 236.1, 1236.1, and

1003.19; the Administrative Procedure Act, 5 U.S.C. § 706(2)(A), and the Fifth Amendment to the United States Constitution. *See* ECF No. 1.

3. On November 21, 2025, Petitioner was transferred to Moshannon Valley Processing Center (“Moshannon Valley”), in the Western District of Pennsylvania, where he is currently detained.

4. On November 24, 2025, Petitioner filed a motion for order to show cause requesting, among other things, that the Court direct Respondents to respond to the petition and enjoin Respondents from removing Petitioner from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. ECF No. 4.

5. On November 25, 2025, this Court granted Petitioner’s motion, ordering Respondents to respond to the petition by December 1, 2025, and enjoining Respondents from removing Petitioner from the Eastern District of Pennsylvania absent further Order of the Court. ECF No. 5.

6. On the same date, counsel for Petitioner and Respondents reached an agreement that: (a) the Court should rule on Yilmaz’s habeas petition on the papers, without conducting a hearing; and (b) the Court should amend its November 25 Order to reflect that Respondents are enjoined from transferring Petitioner outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania absent further Order of the Court, rather than outside the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.

7. Counsel have conferred and jointly request that the Court cancel the hearing and decide the habeas petition on the papers.
