STATUS REPORT REGARDING BOND HEARING

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

COME NOW Respondents, Pamela Bondi, *et al.*, by and through the undersigned counsel of record, and hereby files this Status Report Regarding Bond Hearing:

1.) Petitioner Veronica Arreola Chavez, a Mexican national, filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (Dkt. 1) challenging her continuing civil immigration detention pending removal proceedings.

2.) On December 12, 2025, the Court entered a Memorandum and Order granting in part and denying in part the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and ordering Respondents to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a). (Dkt. 16)

3.) On December 17, 2025, Petitioner was provided a bond hearing before an Immigration Judge (IJ). See Exhibit A - Order of the Immigration Judge. The IJ granted the bond request and set an \$8,000.00 bond. *Id.*

4.) Given that this Court granted the habeas petition in part and that the Government has complied with the Court's order it is the Government's position that the case is resolved.
