**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

The Court is in receipt Mr. Bruno Paul Vincés Romero’s “Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus” (Romero’s “§ 2241 Petition”). Dkt. No. 1. However, the signature block in Romero’s § 2241 Petition does not include his attorney’s telephone number or email address. *See id.* at 21. Romero’s § 2241 Petition is deficient under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 11(a) which requires that every pleading must state “the signer’s address, e-mail address, and telephone number.” FED. R. CIV. P. 11(a). The Court must strike any unsigned pleading “unless the omission is promptly corrected after being called to the attorney’s or party’s attention.” *Id.*

Accordingly, Romero is **ORDERED** to **SHOW CAUSE** no later than **December 3, 2025**, why the Court should not strike his § 2241 Petition from the record for failure to comply with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 11(a).
