The court held an emergency status conference in the above-captioned matter on November 25, 2025. At the status conference, counsel for the Respondents averred that Petitioner Cesar Angel Suyo Apaza has been charged with overstaying his visa, not with entry without inspection. Mr. Suyo Apaza's habeas petition may therefore be moot because, according to counsel, Mr. Suyo Apaza is eligible for a custody redetermination under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) and is not subject to mandatory detention under 8 U.S.C. § 1225(b)(2). But the Notice to Appear or other evidence supporting this assertion has not yet been filed on the docket.

Accordingly, and for the reasons stated on the record, the court reiterated the deadlines in its previous order to show cause. (See Order to Show Cause, Nov. 24, 2025, ECF No. 6.) The court amended its previous order to specify that, other than for purposes of a bond hearing or

release, Mr. Suyo Apaza should not be transferred out of the detention facility at Florence, Arizona, without the prior authorization of this court.

ORDER

For the foregoing reasons, the court ORDERS as follows:

1. The Respondents must show cause why Mr. Suyo Apaza's petition for a writ of habeas corpus should not be granted by **Monday, December 1, 2025**. See 28 U.S.C. § 2243.

The Petitioner's reply, if any, shall be filed by **Wednesday, December 3, 2025**.

2. The parties must appear before this court for a hearing on the petition on **Thursday, December 4, 2025, at 1:00pm** in Courtroom 3.400 of the Orrin G. Hatch United States Courthouse.


3. Mr. Suyo Apaza shall not be removed from the United States unless and until the court orders otherwise.

4. Mr. Suyo Apaza shall not be transferred from the detention facility in Florence, Arizona, without prior authorization from this court, except for purposes of a bond hearing or release.

5. Counsel for Mr. Suyo Apaza shall notify this court and the Respondents immediately if Mr. Suyo Apaza is granted a bond hearing or he is released.
