**STATUS REPORT 2**  
**JUDICIAL ORDER REQUESTED**

20 Pursuant to the Court’s December 3, 2025 order, ECF No. 10, Petitioner provides  
21 this status report conveying that the Petitioner was released from custody. Petitioner  
22 seeks to be truthful with the tribunal, as of 11:00PM Petitioner is finally out of custody  
23 at the multiple requests of Counsel via phone and email to those at Otay Mesa  
24 Detention Center and ICE ERO. As speculated in the previous status update, in  
25 violation of the immigration judge’s order, Petitioner was placed in Alternatives to  
26 Detention including ISAP (aka “ankle GPS monitoring”).

27 This evidences the necessitates the judge’s order under this habeas in order to  
28 seek remedy. It is clear that, as previously argued, ICE is unchecked in their ability to  
overreach in gross violation of Petitioner’s basic rights under the Due Process Clause

1 and cannot adhere to policies and procedures under the APA.
