ORDER OF THE IMMIGRATION JUDGE


The respondent requested a custody redetermination pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 1236. After full consideration of the evidence presented, the respondent's request for a change in custody status is hereby ordered:

After review of the factual submissions and after listening to the testimony of Respondent and the argument of counsel, the undersigned IJ finds that this respondent (1) is not a danger to the community and (2) is a minimal flight risk. This minimal risk is mitigated by a monetary bond. The undersigned IJ specifically finds that detention is not warranted. Regardless, at the specific request of ICE counsel at the bond hearing on 12/1/2025, the undersigned IJ adds the notation if a reviewing court were to determine differently, ICE can consider alternatives to detention.
