

PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS UNDER 28 U.S.C. § 2241

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT:

Petitioner, Gabriel Roblero Mazariegos, by and through his U.S. lawful-permanent-resident uncle and next friend,

Axel Roblero Arreaga, respectfully petitions this Honorable Court for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241

and states as follows:

## I. INTRODUCTION

1. Petitioner is a young immigrant currently detained at Broward Transitional Center in Florida since August 20, 2025, after

an irregular and improper arrest conducted in Naples, Florida.

2. Petitioner has no living parents. His mother died at childbirth, and his father passed away during the Covid-19 pandemic.

3. Since early childhood, Petitioner has been fully raised, supported, and cared for by his uncle and aunt, Axel Roblero

Arreaga and his spouse, who consider him a son. Petitioner was part of their household and contributed to the family's

economic stability.

4. Petitioner has no family in Guatemala and would face complete family separation if deported.

5. Petitioner has no criminal history and does not pose a danger to the community or a flight risk. His continued detention

is unnecessary, punitive, and violates due process.

II. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

6. This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 because Petitioner is being held "in custody" under federal authority in this District.


7. Venue is proper in the Southern District of Florida because Broward Transitional Center is located within this District.

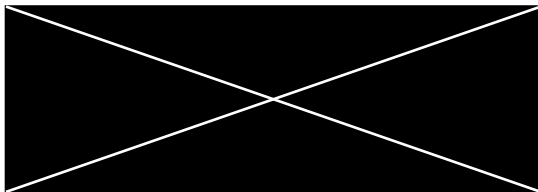

- Qualifies as next friend because Petitioner is detained, young, and unable to litigate this action on his own.

IV. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

10. Petitioner was detained on August 20, 2025, in Naples, Florida, under irregular circumstances suggesting unlawful arrest

and improper processing.

11. Petitioner was transferred to Broward Transitional Center, where he remains deprived of liberty.

12. Petitioner has no family in Guatemala. His only family and emotional and economic stability come from his uncle and aunt

in the United States.

13. Petitioner has no criminal history, no flight risk, and strong family and community ties.

14. His prolonged detention violates his substantive and procedural due process rights under the Fifth Amendment.

#### V. LEGAL BASIS FOR RELIEF

15. Under *Zadvydas v. Davis*, 533 U.S. 678 (2001), prolonged immigration detention without justification violates constitutional

protections.

16. Under *Demore v. Kim*, detention must be reasonable in duration and tied to its intended purpose. Prolonged detention of a

young man with no criminal record is neither reasonable nor justified.

17. Petitioner has a strong constitutional interest in family unity, which is being violated by his prolonged and unjustified

detention.

18. ICE has less restrictive alternatives, such as supervised release, that would satisfy any governmental interest without continued detention.

VI. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Order Petitioner's immediate release from ICE custody under appropriate conditions of supervision;
2. Grant a writ of habeas corpus, finding that Petitioner's ongoing detention violates his constitutional rights;
3. Provide any other relief the Court deems just and proper.

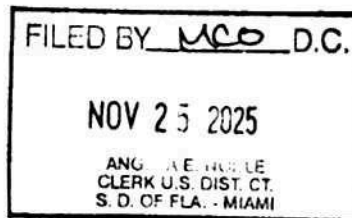

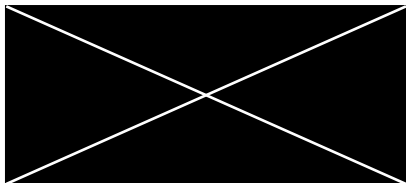
