RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT

Respondents file this status report to the court pursuant to the Court's Order (ECF No. 12), to confirm whether Petitioner has been released under conditions no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue in this case.

Prior to this most recent detention Petitioner was previously enrolled in a form of Alternative in Detention ("ATD"). *See* Exh. A (I 213) at 3. Prior to his release Petitioner was reenrolled in ATD upon his release, to include ankle monitor.

Petitioner's counsel notified Respondent's counsel that this restriction is more than restrictive than Petitioner was subjected to prior to the detention at issue in this case.

Respondents have instructed ICE to remove the ankle monitor. ICE has confirmed that they will schedule a removal of the monitor. ICE intends to review its records to confirm exact conditions of past restrictions and may update the Court in the future.

Counsel has also advised Petitioner's counsel of the same.
