Respondents' Advisory to the Court Regarding Petitioner's Release

Respondents file this Advisory to notify the Court of Petitioner's physical removal from the United States, which action moots this habeas challenge to the legality of her extended detention. *See Bacilio-Sabastian v. Barr*, 980 F.3d 480, 483 (5th Cir. 2020); *Ortez v. Chandler*, 845 F.2d 573, 575 (5th Cir. 1988); *Riley v. I.N.S.*, 310 F.3d 1253, 1257 (10th Cir. 2002); *Virani v. Huron*, 2020 WL 7405655, at *3 (W.D. Tex. Dec. 17, 2020). On or about November 26, 2025, Petitioner brought this habeas claim, seeking release from detention. ECF No. 1. On December 1, 2025, ICE removed Petitioner. Exh. A at 2 (Declaration of DHS Supervisory Detention and Deportation Officer Gabriel Esquivel (redacted)). The relief Petitioner sought, namely release, has already occurred. This petition is, therefore, moot.
