Joint Advisory of Factual Stipulations

Pursuant to the Court's Order [ECF No. 5], the Parties advise the Court of the following factual stipulations:

1. Petitioner is a citizen and national of Pakistan.
2. Petitioner is not a citizen or national of the United States.
3. Petitioner arrived in the United States at or near Tecate, California on or about June 23, 2023, at or near a port of entry.
4. Petitioner was not then admitted or paroled after inspection by an immigration officer.
5. On or about June 25, 2023, ICE issued Petitioner a Notice to Appear with the immigration court alleging he is inadmissible under INA § 212(a)(6)(A)(i).
6. Petitioner was detained on or about November 16, 2025, by ICE, and is in custody at the Limestone County Correctional Facility in Groesbeck, Texas.
7. Petitioner is currently scheduled for a final individual hearing on the detained docket regarding relief from removal before the immigration judge on January 8, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. (See EOIR Automated Case Information, last accessed Dec. 17, 2025).

The Parties agree that the factual issues and the matter are fully briefed and that the Court can rule on the pleadings.
