

Declaration

1. My name is Grigor, I'm 55 y.o. father of 6. I'm citizen of Russia and Armenia
2. I came from Russia because I was victim of persecution, torture for [REDACTED] I got a severe health damage. I asked political asylum right at the border and did not try to hide from American authorities.
3. I arrived to USA at 2022, but in September of 2024 I was detained and I still in ICE custody (14 month)
4. At November of 2025 I won my case and got immigration relief - CAT (conviction against torture), but I still in ICE custody
5. Detention condition are same as a prison and impact my health daily
6. I violate no law in USA for 2 years when I was at freedom, also I made no ICE order violations. In time of my detention I committed no violations too.
7. ICE refused to inform me about term of my release, also they provided no evidence of my community or flight risk. There is no country where I can securely can be deported and it make my imprisonment de facto infinite.
8. I will live with my sponsor and work as handyman.
9. I will accept any form of monitoring
10. When I asked a bond hearing I got an answer "I have no jurisdiction", I never have a chance for a bond hearing for all 14 months of my detention.

11. After I be released, I again can be together with my family. Because my condition and detention their lives are extremely harsh. My sister is a American citizen and have a terminal condition (cancer) and need my support. My kids and wife need my support too. My wife is exhausted by her own disability and my youngest daughter, who American citizen too grow without father

12. All my life I provided my family by myself and it painful for me to watch at their struggles

13. I have a lot of medical conditions and illnesses. Both facilities where I was detained confirm them, but have no capabilities to help me.

I have a compression fracture of T12 vertebral body, thoracic compression fracture. It's a reason of chronic back pain and make me partially disabled. I have pain in my heart, insomnia, anxiety, post traumatic flash backs because tortures. I cannot eat solid food because my teeth condition, I have a high blood pressure and pre diabetes. Stone in my kidney is a reason of strong pain which doctors cannot help.

My health deteriorate but I still dream to be contributing member of society and work as I worked before of my detention.
