27 within seven days of the Court's December 18, 2025 order. ECF No. 16. The government was unable
28 to respond to Petitioner's counsel before a break in the holidays, so the parties did not file a joint status
report at that time. In light of the parties' position regarding further briefing, and the fact that Petitioner
has been released, the parties believe that this delay has created no undue prejudice, however, and ask
that the Court excuse the delay.
