**Respondents' Status Report**

COME NOW Respondents, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas, hereby file their Status Report confirming that Saul Alejandro Amador-Acevedo has been released:

1) On January 9, 2026, Respondents were directed to release Petitioner from custody, under conditions no more restrictive than those in place before the detention at issue, to a public place by 12:00 p.m. on January 13, 2026, and 2) notify Petitioners' counsel of Petitioners release. ECF No. 12 at 2. Additionally, Respondents were directed to file a status report no later than 12:00 p.m. on January 14, 2026, confirming that Petitioner had been released on restrictions no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue. *Id.*

2) Counsel has confirmed with ICE that Petitioner was released on January 10, 2026, on his own recognizance. *See* Exh. A (I-830).
