RESPONDENTS' ADVISORY TO THE COURT

Respondents file this advisory to the court pursuant to the Court's Order (ECF No. 8), to confirm whether Petitioner has been released under conditions no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue in this case.

1) Respondents were ordered to release Petitioner from custody, under restrictions no more restrictive than those in place before the detention at issue in the case, to a public place by 12:00 p.m. on January 8, 2026.

2) Respondents were further directed to notify Petitioner's counsel of record by email of the exact location of his release as soon as practicable and at least two (2) hours before his release.

3) On January 7, 2026, Petitioner's counsel of record was notified of his pending release as ordered by the Court. Shortly thereafter, on said date, Petitioner was released on conditions no more restrictive than previously imposed prior to this detention.

4) Prior to Petitioner's detention he was under an Order of Supervision (OSUP) with GPS monitoring. Upon his release, Petitioner was reenrolled into ATD.
