REPORT REGARDING OUTCOME OF BOND HEARING

Pursuant to the Court's Order Granting Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, Respondents, by and through the undersigned Assistant United States Attorney, submit this report regarding the outcome of the bond hearing in Petitioner Mahan Mohammadimotaheri's removal proceedings. The Immigration Judge provided a bond hearing to Petitioner Mahan Mohammadimotaheri on January 16, 2026 and granted release subject to a \$10,000 bond. A copy of the Order of the Immigration Judge is attached hereto as Exhibit A. As of this writing, Petitioner Mahan Mohammadimotaheri has posted a bond but not been released from custody. Petitioner's release is pending ICE's review of the bond and finalization of the I352 Bond contract.
