26 Pursuant to the Court's December 26, 2025 Order, ECF No. 7, Respondents provide  
27 the following information concerning Petitioner's bond determination hearing.

28 Petitioner's bond determination hearing was held on January 5, 2026. According to  
the written order of the Immigration Judge (IJ), "[t]he parties requested additional time to  
submit evidence. Although the District Court Order require[d] a bond hearing within 10  
days of the December 26, 2025 Order, the Court is unable to accomplish that deadline due  
to the need to submit additional evidence." The IJ therefore continued the proceeding to  
January 8, 2026 at 8:00am.

At today's bond determination hearing, the IJ ordered that Petitioner (i) be "released  
from custody under bond of \$5,000"; and (ii) "must comply with any monitoring  
requirements set by the [U.S. Department of Homeland Security] at their discretion."

1 The IJ's order reflects that both DHS and Petitioner waived the opportunity to appeal  
2 the IJ's bond determination order.
