ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Evelin Josefina Perez and her minor son, SJZP, filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. (ECF No. 1). They allege that Respondents have detained them without a bond hearing in violation of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA). The petition is unclear about where United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) is detaining Perez and her son. But it alleges that ICE intends to transfer them to Texas sometime “this evening or tomorrow morning.” (*Id.*, PageID.2, ¶ 4). Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Perez and her son show cause in writing no later than **Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at 5:00 P.M.** verifying the exact location where ICE is

currently detaining them (including the name of the facility and where the facility is located in Michigan).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondents are **enjoined** from removing Perez and her minor son from this district – in the event they are currently detained within the territorial jurisdiction of the Eastern District of Michigan – **until further directed by the Court.** *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1651; *see also* 28 U.S.C. § 102(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Perez’s counsel is directed to serve a copy of this order to show cause on Respondents by **Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at 12:00 P.M.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Perez’s counsel is directed to file on the docket an affidavit or declaration attesting to service of this order on the Respondents forthwith.
