

that the parole is conditioned on complying with the terms and conditions of release. Attached as **Exhibit A** to this declaration is a true and correct copy of the Interim Notice Authorizing Parole.

4. Also at the time of release, ICE enrolled ABDI in the Alternatives to Detention (ATD)/ Intensive Supervision Appearance Program (ISAP). ICE served ABDI an ATD Enrollment form and a Participant Agreement form, signed by ABDI, which contained, among other instructions, a warning that “Failure to comply with the requirements of the ATD program will result in a redetermination of you[r] release conditions or your arrest and detention.” The forms instructed ABDI to report to the ICE office by October 23, 2024 for completion of enrollment in the ATD program. Attached as **Exhibit B** to this declaration are true and correct copies of the ATD Enrollment and Participant Agreement forms.

5. On October 23, 2024, ABDI reported to the ISAP/ATD office in Bloomington, MN as directed and was further oriented to the terms of the ATD release agreement. The ISAP office provided ABDI a program orientation and enrollment briefing regarding his responsibilities under ATD. ABDI was assigned GPS monitoring as his technology option and the compliance monitoring terms were explained to him. ABDI was also provided a copy of the ATD/ISAP Program Rules Agreement, which included notice that failure to comply could result in ICE altering the conditions of his release, to include “increased case management, increased technology assignment, or detention.” ABDI acknowledged and agreed to these conditions by signing the program agreement on October 23, 2024. Attached as **Exhibit C** to this declaration are true and correct copies of the ISAP Program

Rules.

6. On November 5, 2025, an ISAP case specialist attempted to complete a virtual office visit with the participant, which was unsuccessful.

7. On November 6, 2025, ABDI violated the terms of the agreement by failing to report for his scheduled office visit.

8. On December 4, 2025, ICE/ERO St. Paul arrested ABDI for continuation of removal proceedings, which was a direct result of ABDI's documented violation of the ISAP/ATD terms.

9. ABDI's next immigration court hearing is scheduled for January 15, 2026.
