

PETITIONER'S OPINION REGARDING THE BAUTISTA V. SANTACRUZ CLASS

To the Honorable Judge Stephen V. Wilson:

I, Luigie Martin Sagastegui Ronceros, Petitioner in this case, respectfully submit this brief opinion as ordered by the Court on January 13, 2026.



I believe I am a member of the *Bautista v. Santacruz* class. I am currently detained by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) at the Adelanto Detention Center, under the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles Field Office. Since my detention began on October 22, 2025, I have been held in a manner that I believe is arbitrary. I contend that ICE has failed to provide a meaningful, individualized assessment of my case as required by the protections established for class members in this jurisdiction.

Beyond the legal requirements, I humbly ask this Court for the opportunity to be heard or that the Court grant my request for a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) for my release. My detention has not only been a challenge for me but a heavy burden for my family, who wait for me with hope. I am not a danger to this community. **I have a consistent record of compliance; I have never missed an immigration court date or an ICE check-in prior to this detention.**

I ask for this opportunity so that I may show that I am a man of my word, dedicated to my family, and respectful of the laws of this country. I pray that this Court considers my membership in the *Bautista* class and grants me the due process that every human being deserves.
