SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE RE:
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION;
SUGGESTION OF MOOTNESS**

1 On December 16, 2025, the Court issued an Order Granting Petitioners' *Ex Parte*
2 Application for Temporary Restraining Order requiring Respondents to release or
3 provide Petitioners with individualized bond hearings before an Immigration Judge
4 pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) within seven (7) days of the Court's Order. (ECF 13.)
5 The Court further ordered Respondents to show cause by December 23, 2025 as to why a
6 preliminary injunction should not issue. (*Id.*) Respondents filed a Response to Order to
7 Show Cause re: Preliminary Injunction on December 22, 2025, informing the court of
8 the scheduling of individualized bond hearings pursuant to the Court's Order. (ECF 14 at
9 Ex. A.)

10 Respondents hereby provide a further update on those hearings. As shown by the
11 Immigration Court orders attached hereto as Exhibits 1-6, bond hearings were provided
12 to all six Petitioners by December 23, 2025. Petitioner Beltran Orduno and Petitioner De
13 Los Santos Serrano were denied release on bond. *See* Exhibits 1 and 3. Petitioner
14 Casillas Vazquez, Petitioner Molina Jacinto, Petitioner Sandoval Lemus and Petitioner
15 Sifuentes Morales were ordered release on bond. *See* Exhibits 2, 4, 5, and 6.

16 Providing Petitioners with the § 1226(a) bond hearings moots the requested
17 preliminary injunction and this habeas petition more generally. *See, e.g., Javier*
18 *Gonzales, et al. v. Kristi Noem, et al.*, 5:25-cv-02054-ODW-BFM, ECF 16 (August 25,
19 2025 minute order by Hon. Judge Wright, denying as moot petitioners' pending request
20 for a preliminary injunction given their receipt of § 1226(a) bond hearings pursuant to
21 TRO, and issuing petitioners an order to show cause re: dismissal); ECF 17 (petitioners'
22 notice of voluntary dismissal); ECF 18 (order dismissing petition). *See also Moises*
23 *Salomon Zaragoza Mosqueda v. Kristi Noem et al.*, 5:25-cv-002304-CAS-BFM, ECF 15
24 (September 17, 2025 minute order by Hon. Judge Snyder, denying preliminary
25 injunction and issuing OSC re dismissal for mootness given the petitioners' receipt of
26 immigration bond hearings); and ECF 16 (notice of voluntary dismissal); *Gilberto*
27 *Gomez Garcia, et al. v. Kristi Noem, et al.*, 5:25-cv-02771-ODW-PD, ECF 13 (October
28 29, 2025 minute order by Hon. Judge Wright, denying as moot petitioners' pending

1 request for a preliminary injunction given receipt of § 1226(a) bond hearings pursuant to
2 TRO); *Francisco Coc Tut v. Kristi Noem*, 5:25-cv-02701-DOC-AGR, ECF 13 (October
3 30, 2025 order denying preliminary injunction as moot and issuing OSC re: dismissal
4 where bond hearings were provided to petitioners pursuant to TRO).

5 Accordingly, Respondents respectfully request that Petitioners voluntarily dismiss
6 this action, or that the Court issue an order to show cause re: dismissal.
