1 Petitioners and Respondents, by and through their counsel of record, hereby notify
2 the Court that each of the named Petitioners in this action have received an individualized
3 bond hearing as required by the Court's order dated December 19, 2025 (ECF No. 9).
4 Petitioner Armenta Rosales withdrew his bond request in order to provide additional
5 documentation required by the immigration judge and will resubmit a bond request. All
6 other Petitioners were granted bond, but not all have been able to post bond at this time.
7 The closure of federal offices by order of the President on December 24 and 26th may
8 further delay the ability to post bond. At this time, no further order from the Court is
9 necessary. The parties will provide an additional joint status report on or before January 6,
10 2026 and anticipate that this action will be able to be dismissed as moot at that time.
