

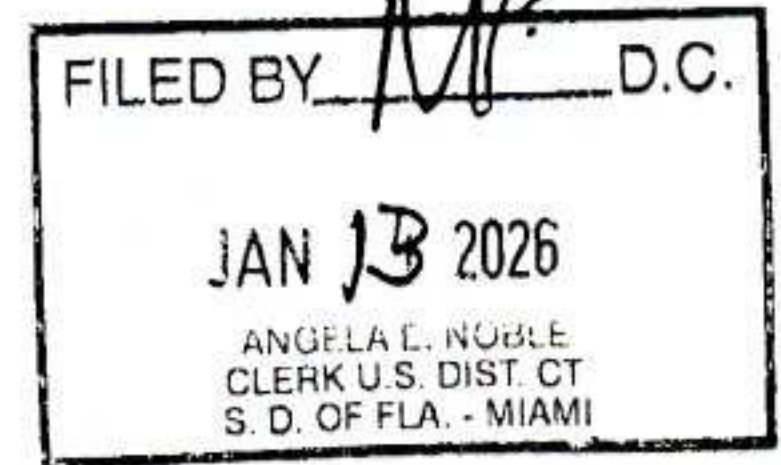

AMENDED PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS (28 U.S.C. § 2241)

Petitioner Anzor Matsev respectfully submits this Amended Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, challenging his continued post-order detention by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) as unlawful under *Zadvydas v. Davis*, 533 U.S. 678 (2001).

Explanation Regarding Prior Inability to Sign and File

Petitioner respectfully submits this Amended Petition signed by him personally. Prior filings submitted on his behalf were not signed or prepared by Petitioner due to circumstances beyond his control related to detention restrictions at Krome Service Processing Center.

Petitioner's ability to prepare and file a habeas corpus petition independently from detention was substantially impaired by limited and unreliable access to legal resources. Petitioner's only means of electronic access to legal information was through a detention-issued tablet, which frequently malfunctioned, lagged, and failed to load legal materials. The tablet did not provide adequate access to federal habeas statutes, procedural rules, or case law necessary to properly prepare a petition under 28 U.S.C. § 2241.

As a result, Petitioner lacked sufficient information and functional access to prepare, format, and file a legally compliant habeas corpus petition without outside assistance, despite reasonable efforts to do so.

On December 18, 2025, at approximately 8:00 p.m., during an in-person visitation at Krome Service Processing Center, Petitioner's wife, Zarina Mustaf, attempted to provide Petitioner with habeas corpus documents for review and signature. Detention officers conducting visitation explicitly denied her request to give Petitioner any documents to sign.

Ms. Mustaf requested to speak with a supervising officer. The supervising officer affirmed the denial and refused to permit Petitioner to receive or sign the documents during visitation. Ms. Mustaf was informed that documents could not be exchanged or signed during visitation under facility procedures.


This visitation, including Ms. Mustaf's presence, her request for Petitioner to sign legal documents, and the supervising officer's denial, was recorded in the facility's visitation logbook, which is maintained by Krome Service Processing Center and may be confirmed by Respondents.

As a result of these combined restrictions, Petitioner was previously unable to independently prepare, sign, or timely submit filings despite reasonable efforts. This Amended Petition is submitted with Petitioner's signature at the first opportunity permitted by detention procedures.

Relief Requested

Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court order Respondents to show cause why Petitioner should not be immediately released from custody, or in the alternative, grant such relief as the Court deems just and proper.
