Joint Stipulation of Facts

1. Petitioner is a citizen and national of Bolivia.
2. Petitioner last entered the United States in or about April 2002 and has resided continuously in the United States ever since.
3. On or about September 17, 2025, ICE detained Petitioner in Washington D.C.
4. On September 17, 2025, ICE arrested Petitioner and issued Petitioner a Notice to Appear alleging that he is inadmissible under INA §§ 212(a)(6)(A)(i); 212(a)(7)(A)(i)(I).
5. Petitioner is currently scheduled for a final individual hearing on the detained docket regarding relief from removal before the immigration judge on December 29, 2025, at 8:30 a.m.

The Parties agree that the factual issues and the matter is fully briefed and the court can rule on the pleadings.
