JOINT STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO ECF NO. 11

The Court granted Petitioner's Amended Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF No. 1) on February 4, 2026, and ordered Respondents to provide Petitioner with a bond hearing under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) within seven days of the order. The Court further ordered the parties to submit a status report within five days of the hearing, stating whether the hearing was held and whether bond was granted or denied. ECF No. 11.

Petitioner received a bond hearing on February 11, 2026, and bond was granted in the amount of \$20,000.
