



within CBP. In November of 2009, I was hired by ICE Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO) as a Deportation Officer, my current position.

3. As a Deportation Officer, my assigned duties are to identify, locate, and arrest aliens illegally present in the United States. Additionally, I am charged with the responsibility of overseeing the cases of aliens in removal proceedings. These duties include the review of alien files for sufficiency, the detention and release of aliens in ICE custody, monitoring the progress of cases through the hearing process, and enforcement of the immigration court's decision, including the execution of removal orders. I am also responsible for presenting criminal immigration cases to the United States Attorney's Office for possible criminal prosecution.

4. Husni Sharif ABDI (Hereinafter referred to as "ABDI") is a citizen and national of Ethiopia. ABDI entered the United States on or about March 11, 2024, near Otay Mesa, CA, without inspection. Attached as **Exhibit A** to this declaration is a true and correct version of the Form I-213 Record of Deportable/Inadmissible Alien related to ABDI.

5. U.S. Border Patrol (USBP) arrested ABDI shortly after his illegal entry and issued him a Form I-862, Notice to Appear on March 13, 2024 and released him on his own recognizance due to lack of available detention space. Attached as **Exhibit B** to this declaration is a true and correct version of the Form I-862 Notice to Appear related to ABDI.

6. On June 19, 2024, ABDI filed Form I-589, Application for Asylum and Withholding of Removal with the immigration court. The application is currently pending.

7. On December 1, 2025, ICE/ERO officers conducting targeted enforcement

operations arrested ABDI in Minneapolis, MN for continuation of removal proceedings. Attached as **Exhibit C** to this declaration is a true and correct version of the Form I-213 Record of Deportable/Inadmissible Alien related to ABDI from the most recent encounter. ICE/ERO determined that ABDI should be detained, and he is currently in custody at the Sherburne County Jail in Elk River, MN.

8. On December 9, 2025, an immigration judge at Fort Snelling, MN denied bond for ABDI. Attached as **Exhibit D** to this declaration is a true and correct version of the immigration judge's order denying bond.

9. ABDI's next immigration court hearing is scheduled for January 16, 2026.
