Bondi, Attorney General of the United States and Mary de Anda Ybarra, Field Office Director of Enforcement and Removal Operation, El Paso Field Office, ICE, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas and hereby file Respondents' Advisory:

1) Petitioner, Franyer Fernandez Sira ("Fernandez Sira") filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus on December 15, 2025. ECF No. 1. On December 19, 2025, the Court ordered Respondents not to (1) remove or deport Fernandez Sira from the United States; or (2) transfer Fernandez Sira to any facility outside the boundaries of the El Paso Division of the Western District of Texas, until the Court orders otherwise or this case is closed. ECF No. 2.

2) Petitioner arrived at El Paso Camp East Montana ("CEM") on December 6, 2025. On December 15, 2025, Petitioner was processed out of CEM and transferred to the Torrance facility in Estancia, New Mexico.
