Respondents' Advisory

COME NOW Respondents, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas and hereby file their Advisory confirming that Jean Carlos Morillo Garcia has been released:

1) On December 23, 2025, the Court ordered Respondents (1) to release Petitioner from custody, under conditions of release no more restrictive than those in place before the detention at issue in this case, to a public place no later than 12:00 p.m. on December 26, 2025, (2) notify Petitioner's next of kin of the time and place of Petitioner's release as soon as possible and no less than two hours before his release, and (3) file a status report no later than 12:00 p.m., December 29, 2025,¹ confirming that Petitioner has been released under conditions of release no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue in this case . ECF No. 7 at 11.

2) On December 29, 2025, Respondents informed the Court that Petitioner, Jean Carlos Morillo Garcia, was released from custody on December 24, 2025. At that time, Respondents did not have information regarding whether Petitioner's next of kin was notified of

the time and place of his release and what Petitioner's conditions of release were. Respondents filed their Status Report indicating that they would supplement said information as soon as it became available. ECF No. 8 at 2.

3) Respondents have been advised that Petitioner was released on December 24, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. Petitioner was released through the front lobby of the facility, and Petitioner's next of kin, Maigualidad Morillo Chourio was notified of his release. In 2023, ERO enrolled Petitioner in the Alternative to Detention ("ATD") program as a condition of his Order of Release on Recognizance. ERO subsequently enrolled Petitioner in ATD again with his new Order of Release on Recognizance.
