STATUS REPORT PURSUANT TO JANUARY 9, 2026, ORDER

1. On January 6, 2026, Petitioner and Respondents appeared before this Court for a hearing on the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus. *See* [DE 7].
2. At the hearing, the Court granted Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and ordered Respondents to provide an individualized bond hearing for the Petitioner within 10 days of this Court's order. *See* [DE 10]. Furthermore, the Court enjoined Respondents from denying bond to Petitioner on the basis that he is detained pursuant to 8 U.S.C. §1225(b)(2). *Id.*

3. On January 14, 2026, a bond hearing was held in Petitioner's removal proceedings and Petitioner was granted release on bond.
