**RESPONDENTS' REQUEST FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME**

On January 23, 2026, the Court issued a minute order, ECF 10, requesting additional documents from the United States and resetting deadlines for the instant habeas petition.

The United States now seeks to have those dates extended until a date convenient for the court and counsel after February 19, 2026.

Petitioner in this case was granted voluntary departure in his underlying immigration case, and has until February 12, 2026, to depart the United States. Should he not depart by that time, a final order of removal may be entered. Given that these developments may change substantially the posture of the case, the Government requests deadlines for supplementing the record and briefing be appropriately extended to give all parties an opportunity to evaluate the changed circumstances after February 12, 2026.

The United States will update the Court when it receives more information about Petitioner's immigration proceedings.
