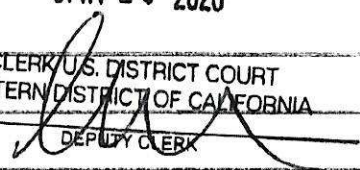

ICE filed a motion to dismiss my Habeas Corpus and this is my reply in regards to the Exhibits submitted. ICE stated that I was released due to a lack of space. That is incorrect. I was released under supervision and did apply for Asylum in which I received work authorization. Once I received my documents, I had started working at FedEx. Many of the violations of the Alternative To Detention Program were due to issues with cell phone signal, app issues, and gps issues, in which they were not working properly. Every time there was a violation due to an issue, USCIS would call me. In the event I was unable to pick up, they would leave a message asking me to report to the office in which I complied. I was arrested for Obstructing a Peace Officer on May 18

2024. It was due to a misunderstanding as I do not

understand English well. The court case is still pending

in which it is being resolved by a conditional

settlement in which I completed 25 hours of community

service and participated and completed a Anger

Management 12 week program. I have my Pre-Trial

set for Wednesday February 4 2026, where I have

to present my certificates to the judge. I had received a

call in which I was told to present myself to the ICE

office where they were going to remove my ankle

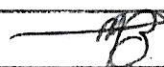
monitor. I was not told that they would be detaining me.

I had been under supervision from ICE since March 4

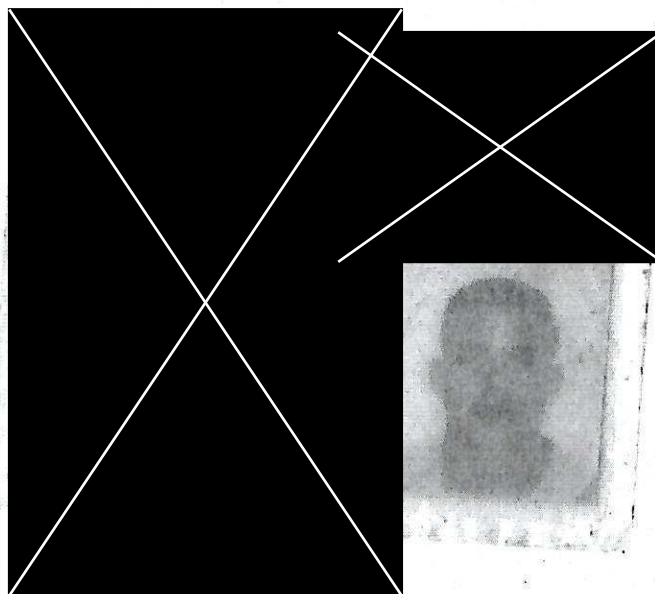
2024 until the day of my arrest by ICE. I have always
