Request

Your Honor,

I've been previously released under supervision and applied for Asylum in which I received work authorization. Once I received my documents, I had started working at FedEx. Many of the violations of the Alternative to Detention Program were due to issues with cell phone signal, app issues, and gps issues in which they were not working properly. Every time there was a violation due to an issue, USCIS would call me. In the event I was unable to pick up, they would leave a message asking me to report to the office in which I complied. I was arrested for Obstructing a Peace Officer on May 18 2024. It was due to a misunderstanding as I do not understand English well. The court case is still

pending in which it is being resolved by a conditional settlement in which I completed 25 hours of community service and participated and completed an Anger Management 12 week program. I have Pre-Trial set for Wednesday February 4 2026, where I have to present my certificates to the judge. I had received a call in which I was told to resent myself to the ICE Office where they were going to remove

my ankle monitor. I was not told that they would be detaining me. I had been under supervision from ICE since March 4 2024 until my arrest by ICE. I have always wanted to do the right thing, which is why I was presenting myself to the office when told to do so.

I also wish to let you know that I did not sign my voluntary departure yet because I wanted to finish my court proceeding so that in the future I may be able to come back to the country if I had left. At the same time, I got scared to return back, as being stuck in detention is affecting me sometimes making me want to be free. I have attached a copy of the certificates and court documents in regards to my criminal court case. On January 28 2026, ICE officers came to Golden State Annex in which I presented them with my court documents showing the Date of my hearing so that they can be able to take me to the proceeding as stated on the National ICE Detainee Handbook.

Request

1) I request that my case is set on the calendar again and assigned a court date to proceed with my asylum case. I want to continue fighting my case.
