**ORDER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
BRIEFING]**

Before the Court is Petitioner Jerry Osazee Osaretin’s (“Petitioner”) Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241. ECF No. 1. Respondents previously acknowledged that Petitioner must be considered detained under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a), pursuant to the final judgment entered in *Maldonado Bautista v. Santacruz*, No. 5:25-CV-01873-SSS-BFM, --- F. Supp. 3d ---, 2025 WL 3289861 (C.D. Cal. Nov. 20, 2025). ECF No. 6. Thus, the Court granted a bond hearing and ordered a subsequent status report. ECF No. 7. On January 5, 2026, Respondents filed a status report stating that the bond hearing was held December 31, 2025, where the bond request was “withdrawn” to give Petitioner further opportunity to provide evidence. ECF No. 8. In light of this order, the Court **ORDERS** the parties to file separate status reports by **January 16, 2026**, including at least the following information: (1) the status of further bond hearings, including when the next

1 hearing will be set for; and (2) each parties' respective position as to how the Court should
2 proceed with the rest of the relief Petitioner seeks in the original petition.

3 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
