JOINT STATUS UPDATE

The parties submit this update pursuant to the Court's December 30, 2025 Order. (ECF 10). Mr. Cibrian Matute appeared (virtually) before an immigration judge for a bond hearing on January 5, 2026, at approximately 9:00am. After hearing arguments from the parties, the immigration judge denied bond, determining that the immigration court did not have jurisdiction over the bond hearing, pursuant to the Laken Riley Act, Public Law 119-1, given a prior shoplifting arrest. Mr. Cibrian reserved his administrative appeal rights. The deadline for filing the appeal is February 4, 2026.

Respondents believe that no additional district court proceedings are required or appropriate for this matter and that the Court should mark this matter closed.

Petitioner is considering whether to pursue additional relief from the district court.
