1. Background

Mr. Khalid Abukablan entered the United States on December 1, 1990. His visa expired in 1995, and he has remained in the U.S. since then. He has lived continuously in the United States for over 34 years. He was taken from his home by ICE on October 10, 2025.

2. Criminal History (Old and Resolved)

- 1999: Aggravated Battery — over 20 years ago
- 2016: Domestic Violence — served 11 months and 12 days

All sentences completed.

3. Countries Refusing Removal

Saudi Arabia and Egypt refused to accept him. Removal is not reasonably foreseeable, violating *Zadvydas v. Davis*.

4. Legal Basis for Habeas Corpus

Under 28 U.S.C. § 2241, continued detention is unlawful because:

- Removal is not reasonably foreseeable.
- Detention has no further legal purpose.
- Due process violation.
- Strong community ties; living in the U.S. since 1990.

5. Relief Requested

Immediate supervised release.

Order ICE to provide proof of removal likelihood.

Any additional relief the Court finds proper.
