Respondents' Status Report

COME NOW Respondents, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas and hereby file their Status Report confirming that Lelya Amirian, M.A. have been released:

1) On January 5, 2026, Respondents were directed to release Petitioners Lelya Amirian and M.A. from custody together, under conditions no more restrictive than those in place before the detention at issue, to a public place by 12:00 p.m. on January 8, 2026, and 2) notify Petitioners' counsel of Petitioners release. ECF No. 9 at 11. Additionally, Respondents were directed to file a status report no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 8, 2026, confirming that Petitioners have been released under conditions of release no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue in this case. *Id.*

2) Petitioners Lelya Amirian and M.A. were released on January 8, 2026, at approximately 8:30 a.m. under an Order of Release on Recognizance ("OREC"). Petitioners' counsel was contacted by ERO on January 7, 2026 regarding release and Petitioners' travel coordination.
