Respondents offer no defense in this case, acknowledging that all Petitioners are members of the Bond Denial class in *Rodriguez Vazquez v. Bostock*, No. 3:25-cv-05240-TMC, 2025 WL 2782499 (W.D. Wash. Sept. 30, 2025). Dkt. 16 at 3–4. Respondents note that Jose Ismael Recinos-Acosta received a bond hearing on October 1, 2025, but confirm that he was “not issued an alternate bond order” and do not contest his entitlement to a bond hearing under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) based on the previous hearing. *Id.* at 4; *see also* Dkt. 10-10 (making no alternative findings as to flight risk, danger, or bond amount). Accordingly, Petitioners respectfully urge the Court to grant their petition immediately.
