
Pursuant to the Court's Order (ECF 3) setting a briefing schedule in this matter, Petitioner submits this brief reply to the Federal Respondents' Response to Petitioner's Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus (ECF 5).

Unhappy with their record of loss in this District on this issue, Respondents try in vain to re-litigate their losses and point to decisions from other Districts. Rather than go over well-trodden ground, Petitioner will simply point out that his position on his detention is well-settled in this District. This Court need not "reconsider" anything and can be guided by its prior decisions, including, *Belsai D.S. v. Bondi*, --- F. Supp. 3d ---, No. 25-cv-3682 (KMM/EMB), 2025 WL 2802947, at *5 (D. Minn. Oct. 1, 2025); *Eliseo A.A. v. Olson*, No. 25-cv-3381 (JWB/DJF), 2025 WL 2886729, at *4-6 (D. Minn. Oct. 8, 2025); *Avila v. Bondi*, No. 25-cv-3741 (JRT/SGE), 2025 WL 2976539, at *4-5 (D. Minn. Oct. 21, 2025); *Andres R.E. v. Bondi*, No. 25

cv-3946 (NEB/DLM), 2025 WL 3146312, at *2 (D. Minn. Nov. 4, 2025); *Santos M.C. v. Olson*, No. 25-cv-4264 (PJS/DJF), 2025 WL 3281787, at *2 (D. Minn. Nov. 25, 2025); and *Roberto M.F. v. Olson*, No. 25-cv-4456 (LMP/ECW) (D. Minn. Dec. 9, 2025), ECF No. 15.

Petitioner respectfully prays his petition be granted and that Respondents promptly either release him or grant him a bond hearing.
