On January 9, 2026, this Court granted Petitioner's request for a writ of habeas corpus (ECF 8) and ordered Respondents to either give Petitioner a bond hearing or immediately release him from custody. On January 15, 2026, Petitioner had a bond hearing and bond was granted in the amount of \$1,500.00. *Declaration of John Barham, Exhibit A*. Petitioner's bond was paid via wire transfer on January 16, 2026. *Barham Dec., Exhibit B*.

Unfortunately, the Court was correct at ¶ 4 of its Order that additional proceedings are required.

As of this filing, Respondents have refused to release Petitioner and he remains in custody in Elk River, Minnesota. *Barham Dec. ¶¶ 6-8*.

Based upon this, Petitioner requests this Court to enter an Order directing Respondents to immediately release Petitioner and if they do not do so, enter an Order to Show Cause why they should not be held in contempt.
