COME NOW Respondents, by and through the United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas and hereby file their Status Report confirming that Jose Alejandro Mosquera Montero has been released:

1) On January 8, 2026, Respondents were directed to release Petitioner from custody together, under conditions no more restrictive than those in place before the detention at issue, to a public place by 12:00 p.m. on January 12, 2026, and 2) notify Petitioners' counsel of Petitioners release. ECF No. 7 at 14. Additionally, Respondents were directed to file a status report no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 12, 2026, confirming that Petitioner had been released on restrictions no more restrictive than those in place prior to the detention at issue. *Id.*

2) Petitioner was released on January 9, 2026, on his own recognizance. *See* Exh. A (Release Paper Work)
