**[PROPOSED] ORDER
GRANTING PETITIONER'S
EMERGENCY MOTION FOR
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
ORDER**

THIS MATTER comes before the court on Petitioner's Emergency Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction. Having considered the motion, the memorandum, and any exhibits in support thereof, and any subsequent submissions related to the motion, the Complaint, and the applicable law, the Court ORDERS as follows:

1. Petitioner's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is GRANTED.
2. Respondents and all of their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, successors, assigns, and persons acting in concert or participation with them, are hereby ENJOINED and RESTRAINED from removing Petitioner to any country.
3. The court further ORDERS that Respondents, and all of their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, successors, assigns, and persons acting in concert or participation with them, must afford Petitioner the opportunity to post a bond, or to be released on his own recognizance.
4. No security bond is required under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c).

5. The parties shall, within _____ days of this Order, propose a briefing schedule with respect to Petitioner's motion for preliminary injunctive relief. The hearing date shall be no later than _____ days from today.
