25 THIS MATTER comes before the Court on Petitioner's Emergency Motion for a  
26 Temporary Restraining Order. Having considered the motion, the memorandum and exhibits in  
27 support thereof, and any subsequent submissions related to the motion, the Petition, and the  
28 applicable law, the Court ORDERS as follows:

- 29 1. Petitioner's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is GRANTED.

- 1 2. Respondents, and all their officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, successors,  
2 assigns, and persons acting in concert or participation with them, are hereby ENJOINED  
3 and RESTRAINED from detaining Petitioner without a pre-deprivation hearing and from  
4 transferring Petitioner outside of Arizona.
- 5 3. The Court further ORDERS that Respondents, and all their officers, agents, servants,  
6 employees, attorneys, successors, assigns, and persons acting in concert or participation  
7 with them, must immediately release Petitioner from the custody of U.S. Immigration and  
8 Customs Enforcement.
- 9 4. No security bond is required under the Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c).
- 10 5. The parties shall, within 4 days of this Order, propose a briefing schedule with respect to  
11 Petitioner's motion for preliminary injunctive relief. The hearing date shall be no later  
12 than fourteen days from today.

13 It is so ORDERED.
