DECLARATION OF DEPORTATION

I, IAN BLOOM, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am a Deportation Officer (“DO”), employed by the United States Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”), Office of Enforcement and Removal Operations (“ERO”). I am currently assigned to the ERO office at the Northwest ICE Processing Center (“NWIPC”) in Tacoma, Washington, under the ERO Seattle Field Office. My current duties include, among other tasks, to review and process cases for noncitizens detained in ICE custody through the entirety of the immigration case; this includes preparing for facilitating the removal of noncitizens subject to final orders of removal.

1 2. I am familiar with the case of Phuc Huu Nguyen, agency file A  I make this
2 declaration based upon my personal and professional knowledge, information obtained from other
3 individuals employed by ICE, and information obtained from various records and systems
4 maintained by ICE in the regular course of business. I provide this declaration based on the best of
5 my knowledge, information, belief, and reasonable inquiry in the above-captioned case.

6 3. Petitioner was released from ICE custody on January 23, 2026, pursuant to the Court's Order
7 Granting Habeas Petition dated January 23, 2026.

9 best of my knowledge and belief.
