PETITIONER'S NOTICE OF
SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY

IMMIGRATION HABEAS CASE

1 Petitioner Ricardo de Jesus Cisneros, by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully submits
2 this Notice of Supplemental Authority.

3 On January 16, 2026, the Honorable Tena Campbell, United States District Judge for the
4 District of Utah, issued a Memorandum Decision and Order Granting Petition for Writ of Habeas
5 Corpus in *Anderson Donald Aguilar Tanchez v. Kristi Noem, et al.*, Case No. 2:25-cv-01150-TC (D.
6 Utah).

8 In that decision, the Court addressed substantially the same statutory and constitutional issues
9 presented here, including:

- 10
- 11 • whether 8 U.S.C. § 1252(b)(9) bars district court jurisdiction over habeas challenges to
12 immigration detention;
 - 13 • whether detention of interior noncitizens is governed by 8 U.S.C. § 1225(b)(2)(A) or 8 U.S.C.
14 § 1226(a); and
 - 15 • whether DHS's revised interpretation of § 1225(b)(2)(A) eliminating bond hearings for interior
16 noncitizens is lawful.

18 The decision post-dates Respondents' Response and Petitioner's Reply in this matter and bears
19 directly on the questions currently before this Court. Accordingly, Petitioner respectfully brings it to
20 the Court's attention as supplemental authority.

21 A copy of the January 16, 2026 Memorandum Decision and Order in *Aguilar Tanchez* is attached
22 hereto as Exhibit 1.

24 Petitioner submits this Notice solely to apprise the Court of relevant, recent authority and does not
25 seek to re-argue the merits absent the Court's request.
